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1. This is a case of simple past tense. No helping verb is needed.
2. "Energy" is always used in the singular form. To refer to more than one, "energy sources" has been chosen.
3. Spelling this word "ery" instead of "ary" changes the meaning entirely. "Stationery" means writing paper and other writing supplies.
4. "As well as" must be used to show an additional point. Use the word "than" when showing disagreement or contrast.
5. or contrast.
6. "Transportation" is always used in the singular form.
7. Use "an" before nouns which begin with a vowel (a, e, i, o, u) or a vowel sound.
8. Saying "the" stationary bike means there is only one. Because there is more than one, it should be "a" stationary bike.
9. When using two words to create an adjective, they should usually be connected with a hyphen.
10. Using "will" here implies a situation which is sure to take place. However, this is only a suggestion, so "would" is the correct helping verb.

11. If a word ends in “e”, remove the “e” before adding “ing”.
12. “Then” has an entirely different meaning than “than”. Always check your spelling of this word, as using the wrong form is a common mistake even for native English speakers.
